



THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA



Preamble

We, The people of India, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a Sovereign Socialist Secular Democratic Republic and to secure to all its citizen:

JUSTICE – social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity,

and to promote among them all;

FRATERNITY – assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, DO HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.

NATIONAL EMBLEM



सत्यमेव जयते

The National emblem of India is a replica of the Lion Capital of Sarnath, near Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh, the Lion Capital was erected in the third century BC by Emperor Ashoka to mark the spot where Buddha first proclaimed his gospel of peace and emancipation to our four quarters of contemporary India's reaffirmation of its ancient commitment to world peace and goodwill.

The four Lions (one hidden from view) - symbolizing power, courage and confidence - rest on a circular abacus. The abacus is grided by four smaller animals - guardians of the four directions: The lion of the north, the elephant of the east, the horse of the south and the bull of the west. The abacus rests on a lotus in full bloom, exemplifying the fountain head of the life and creative inspiration. The motto "Satyameva Jayate" inscribed below the emblem in Devanagiri Script means 'Truth Alone Triumphs'.

FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES

Duties of the Citizens of India (Under Article 51A, Part IV A)

*Inserted by the 42nd Amendment in 1976.
It shall be the duty of Every Citizen of India.*

- (a) To abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem.
- (b) To cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom.
- (c) To uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India.
- (d) To defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so.
- (e) To promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women.
- (f) To value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture.
- (g) To protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life, and to have compassion for living creatures.
- (h) To develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform.
- (i) To safeguard public property and to abjure violence.
- (j) To strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the Nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.

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SCHOOL RULES

1. A student must carry his / her Almanac to school everyday. It must have his /her photograph and complete information signed by parents. Almanac must be regularly checked and signed by parents.
2. Students who come to school in their own transport should arrive at school 10 minutes before the school bell rings.
3. The school uniform should be worn on every working day. Students should be neatly dressed. Shirts should be neatly tucked into trousers / skirts & school belt must be clearly visible. Low waist skirts and trousers are strictly prohibited. Socks must be at least six inches above the ankle. Shoes must be polished every day.
4. Girls should plait their hair if it is below the shoulders. Short hair should be neatly cut and pinned. Long pony tail or open hair is also not allowed. Boys should cut their hair at regular intervals.
5. Students are expected to respect the property of others. This includes respect for school property. No student should damage any school furniture, write or draw anything on the walls/ furniture or in any way damage things belonging to others. Damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the Class teacher. In case of any damage done the person responsible for the act has to pay for the same.
6. The school is not responsible for goods lost. It is advisable not to bring valuable articles to school.
7. Please do not send gifts on your ward's birthday.
8. Students should be polite wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their conduct.
9. Every student must carry his / her lunch, water bottle, a napkin and a small towel. The name, class and section of the pupil should be neatly marked on their belongings.
10. Parents and guardians cannot visit their wards or teachers without the permission of the Principal.

11. Once students enter the school premises they cannot leave without the explicit written permission of the Principal / Class teacher. In case they violate this rule, strict disciplinary action will be taken.
12. Parents, please note that once a child has come to school, he /she should not be called on phone or asked to come home on half day leave or leave from any period. In case of grave emergencies, permission should be taken from the Principal. Out station trips should be strictly avoided on working days, and no permission will be granted to leave school early to catch a flight / train etc. Parents are requested not to fix medical appointments or any kind of social engagements during working hour.
13. The school reserves the right to suspend students where progress in studies or conduct is found to be unsatisfactory.
14. Late comers and uniform defaulters will be sent home.
15. Parents should attend the meetings regularly.
16. Students must not miss any teaching / games / library / activity period.
17. No student shall indulge in any of the following practices
 - (a) Spitting in or near the school building
 - (b) Disfiguring or otherwise damaging school property
 - (c) Rude behaviour
 - (d) Use of violence in any form
18. Attendance is compulsory on the first and last working day of every term.
19. Expensive articles like cameras, mobile phones, iPods etc are strictly prohibited. In case of violation of this rule, the article will be confiscated and strict disciplinary action will be taken. Children should not wear expensive jewellery to school. The school bears no responsibility for articles lost in school. In case of loss, a letter giving details of the article may be sent to the Class teacher.

BUS RULES

For a safe journey to school, the following rules are to be followed by the students.

1. It will be the responsibility of the parents to ensure that their ward reach the pickup points well in time, as the bus will not wait for the child. In case if the child has missed the bus, the parents are requested to take the child to the next pickup point from where he / she can board the bus and NOT TO ASK the driver to return to their stop.
2. Students should travel by their regular bus route. Each student is expected to board or get down from the school bus only at his / her regular stop, not just anywhere as per his / her convenience.
3. It is important to inform the administrative office, transport incharge and class teacher about any change in address and telephone number.
4. The school does not entertain any request for change in bus routes to suit an individual's convenience. Change of bus stop for a day or for a week is not entertained. As a rule, such requests should not be made.
5. In case of emergency, parents should take their child personally from the school with the permission of the Principal. It will be appreciated if such information is sent to the school in advance.
6. The drivers are authorized to stop buses at the designated stop only unless directed by the transport incharge. The list of stops is prepared keeping in view for the convenience and safety of all bus commuters and is always subject to change.
7. It is mandatory to collect the identity card from the Class teacher. The students are advised to wear the identity card on all working days.
8. Parents are requested to fill up the Transport Information Card, if there is any change in address, phone numbers or bus route.
9. Parents should co-operate with the bus driver and the bus incharge.

DISCIPLINE IN THE BUS

1. Maintain discipline in the bus so that the bus driver's attention is not diverted.
2. Do not jump on or off a moving bus as it is dangerous.
3. Do not push each other when you get on or off the bus.
4. Never stand in front or behind a stationary bus.
5. Students should treat bus attenders and drivers with courtesy.
6. Objects of any kind must not be discarded inside or thrown out of the bus.
7. No student should come near the door of the bus unless it has made a complete stop.
8. All students must occupy vacant seats immediately after boarding the bus.
9. Unruly behaviour like shrieking and shouting in the bus is strictly prohibited. Courteous behaviour is expected at all times.
10. The bus incharge and student bus monitors are responsible for maintaining discipline in the buses. Kindly ensure that your ward listens to them.
11. Bus facility will be offered depending on the availability of seats in bus.
12. If you are using private transport, please ensure that you give your driver's vehicle number and child's details to the class teacher. It is mandatory to collect the private vehicle entry pass from the transport department.

Note :

The students violating the above rules will be strictly punished which may include suspension or expulsion from the school.

Any problem, suggestion, comment regarding transport should be brought to the notice of the Principal or Transport incharge immediately so that the problem can be sorted out at the earliest.

RECOMMENDATION TO PARENTS / GUARDIAN

1. Parents and students are requested to read carefully all the rules and regulations mentioned in the Almanac.
2. Please check the uniform, haircut and punctuality of your ward regularly.
3. It is always advisable to write to the class teacher in the Almanac about the problems of your ward.
4. Check and sign your ward's Almanac daily. Do read the remarks if any, and take necessary action.
5. See that your ward carries books according to the Time Table.
6. See and sign his / her Report card and teacher's remarks in his class work / home work books and Almanac.
7. Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports.
8. Your ward should be instructed to be careful about his / her things. There should be a name tag on bags, tiffin - boxes and water bottles.
9. If your ward is absent from school he / she must make up all the work missed by him / her.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

GENERAL

1. Parents should not go directly to the class to meet the teachers or the children.
2. Parents are requested to come only on Saturdays with prior appointment to meet the teachers.
3. Parents can meet the Principal only with prior appointment.

WITHDRAWAL

1. If a child is withdrawn immediately after admission, a quarter's fee and a months proportionate annual charges are to be paid.
2. Transfer certificate will not be issued until all dues of the school are settled.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

1. Students can avail the school transport, subject to the availability of seats
2. The routes of the school buses are decided by the school and the parents should consult the school transport incharge for necessary details.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

1. Attendance is compulsory on the first and last working day of every term.
2. Students who have been sick and absent for more than three consecutive days should bring a medical certificate from their doctor on joining school.
3. Students absent on the previous day will not be admitted to the class without a note from the parent addressed to the Class teacher stating the reasons for the absence.
4. Prior approval from principal is mandatory for any planned leave.
5. In case of an emergency parents will be informed and they will have to report to the Principal. They are not permitted to go to the classes directly.
6. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class.
 - (a) Chicken Pox – Till complete falling of the scabs.
 - (b) Cholera – Till the child is completely recovered.
 - (c) Measles – Two weeks after the rash disappears.
 - (d) Mumps – Until the swelling has gone : about one month
 - (e) Jaundice – Six weeks after recovery.

NATIONAL FLAG

The Indian flag was designed as a symbol of freedom. The late Prime Minister Nehru called it a flag not only of freedom for ourselves, but a symbol of freedom to all people.

The flag is a horizontal tricolor in equal proportion of deep saffron on the top, white in the middle and dark green at the bottom. The ratio of the width to the length of the flag is a wheel in navy blue to indicate the Dharma Chakra, the wheel of law in the Saranath Lion Capital. Its diameter approximates the width of the white band and it has 24 spokes. The saffron stands for courage, sacrifice and the spirit of renunciation; the white, for purity and truth; the green for fertility.
